OM SWASTI

MI GYUR LHAN KHAY NYOOK MAY TSHAY PA MAY

The indestructible, self-born essence of Amitayus.

YAY NAY KYAY CHI TSEN MAY MA GÖ PA

Primordially uncharacterized by either birth or death.

CHÖ NYI KA NAY DAK PAY DEN PA YI

By the truth of the fundamental purity of phenomenality itself.

DRO GÖN GYAL WAY NYU GU ZHAP TEN SOL

May the supreme guide of beings, the Victorious One, may he live a long life.

ROL TSAL MA GAK DAY CHEN DOR JAY TRIN

With the unobstructed creativity of the vajra clouds of highest ecstasy

KHA KHYAP GYU TRUL DA WAY DÖ GAR KHEN

Expanding through space, the skillful dance of Mayajala,

CHÖ CHEN TEN DEL LHUN DUP DEN PA YI

With the truth of the spontaneity of interdependent phenomena.

DRO GÖN GYAL WAY NYU GU ZHAP TEN SOL

May the supreme guide of beings, the Victorious One, may he live a long life.

JIK MAY KHYEN TSAY NU PAY YAY SHAY KYI

With the fearlessness ('jigs-med), wisdom and kindness which is the power of primordial awareness (ye-shes),

NGAY SANG TEN PAY NYING PO WANG GI GYAL

the essence of the precise, secret teachings (bstan-pa'i) (of the Vajrayana), the wish-fulfilling jewel,

SHAY DUP TIN LAY GYAL TSHEN TSER KÖ NAY

The victorious banner (rgyal-mtshan) of teaching, practice and action is raised to the pinnacle;

DO WAY RAY DÖ KONG ZHIN TSHO ZHAY SOL

May he live long as he fulfills the aspirations and wishes of living beings.

TA SHE RAY KHA YAY KHIL CHÖ KYI DUNG

(Sounding) the Dharma as a conch shell trumpet with the auspicious (bkra-shis) pattern of a right handed spiral,

SA SUM KYAY GU NA WAY CHU LEN DU

(Causing) the essence to enter the ears of many beings of the three habitats (above, on the surface and below the earth),

PEL WAY GAY TSEN CHOK LAY NAM GYAL PAL

Accomplishing the spread of virtue victoriously (rnam-rgyal dpal) in all directions,

KAL ZANG DEN CHOK WANG PO ZHAP TEN SOL

May this fortunate (bzang) supreme guide and sovereign (po) live a long life.

RIK DZIN LA MAY ZHAP PAY KAL GYAR TEN

May the Lama Vidyadhara live for a hundred eons;

CHI NANG BAR CHAY MI TEN YUL LAY GYAL

Victorious in the war against adverse inner and outer obstacles,

TEN DO DÖN CHEN ZHAY GU LHUN GYI DUP

Spontaneously accomplishing vast intentions of great value to the Dharma and living beings,

PUN TSHOK TA SHE NANG WAY TAK KHYAP SHOK

May this most excellent auspicious vision pervade forever.
